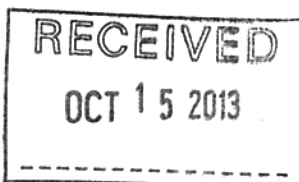

**RE: Follow-Up to meeting of September 26, 2013**

Further to our meeting of September 26<sup>th</sup> 2013, I wish to thank you for the opportunity to meet to discuss opportunities for improving the access to the GO Transit regional network by the Liberty Village community in your ward. As discussed Metrolinx looks forward to exploring with you, the TTC and the City the following:

- the feasibility of fare integration (including a premium fare option) between the TTC and GO Transit utilizing the Presto card technology, to afford Liberty Village residents and employees an option other than the King St. TTC streetcar with shorter travel times to and from the downtown core,
- potential for integrating a new GO/UP Express station adjacent to the Liberty Village within the future development of the lands owned by First Capital abutting the Georgetown/Kitchener corridor.

As a next step, please advise who at the City of Toronto and TTC we should contact to advance these two items. Leslie Woo, our Vice President, Policy, Planning & Innovation (416-202-5943) will be assigning staff to work on the planning and analysis.
